

Playground Grants and Funding Opportunities Manitoba

The Winnipeg Foundation

The Foundation's main grants program which supports a wide range of community projects (Up to \$100,000)

Access Credit Union – Focused Funding Grant

The Focused Funding Grant from Access Credit Union provides up to \$25,000 in support to 10 Manitoba public schools each year. This grant is designed to help schools strengthen student well-being through projects that enhance nutrition programs, improve recreation and play spaces, and create welcoming, community-focused environments.

The Manitoba GRO Program

Rural municipalities can now apply for grant funding through the new Manitoba Growth, Renewal, and Opportunities for Municipalities (Manitoba GRO) program. This funding covers up to 50% of eligible costs for capital projects in areas such as public safety, recreational infrastructure, roads and active transportation, and solid waste management.

The Community Incentive Grant Program (C.I.G.P.)

The Community Incentive Grant Program of the City of Winnipeg is designed to encourage non-profit community organizations to undertake improvements or purchase capital assets that are available for public use or will enhance public use of a space or facility.

Co-op Community Spaces

Co-op Community Spaces has been developed to help protect, beautify and improve spaces across Western Canada. In keeping with our ongoing commitment to invest in the communities we serve, Co-op will contribute \$1 million to help support projects that improve the places Canadians meet, play, learn and share. Since 2015, 147 local projects have been supported with \$10.5 million dollars in capital funding.

Building Sustainable Communities Program

For capital projects with eligible project cost of over \$150,000 (larger capital) a maximum provincial contribution of 50 per cent of eligible project costs incurred to complete the project has been increased to a maximum grant of up to \$300,000.

Manitoba Liquor & Lotteries

Manitoba Liquor & Lotteries supports a wide range of charitable, non-profit and community groups in meaningful, impactful ways – contributing millions of dollars, and thousands of employee volunteer hours, that add lasting value to the lives of Manitobans through festival and event sponsorships and donations.

Community Foundation of Portage and District

The Community Foundation of Portage and District is dedicated to enhancing the quality of life for individuals within their community. CFPD provides an extensive grant program tailored to support the vitality and

development of our community. Grants are available across a diverse range of areas to promote inclusivity and ensure comprehensive support.

Tire Stewardship Manitoba

The Tire Stewardship Manitoba (TSM) Community Enhancement Grant offers funding for projects that incorporate recycled tire materials, benefiting Manitoba communities and non-profit organizations. The grant covers up to 50% of the project cost, with a maximum of \$10,000 per approved project. This funding allows communities and non-profits to utilize and benefit from various recycled tire products. Grant eligibility is limited to one grant per community organization per calendar year.
